Avenue Art Days 2017: Hidden Gems will encourage Wichitan's and visitors to step outside, explore their own backyard, and discover the many hidden treasures found throughout, from finely crafted beer or flavorful foods, creative art and designs or innovative ideas. Artist/ artwork selections are determined by the DDD board to be announced September 9th, based on the following criteria:

- Fits 2017 theme - "Hidden Gems"
- Fits building/ location and any particular parameters, if applicable
- Feasibility of completion within specified timeframe

- Artist's Experience
- Visual Appeal - Objective is to create aesthetically pleasing "Design" in the District and potential destinations and photo ops for Wichitan's and visitors
